

## Four Patch One-Hour Pillow with Trim

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### Materials

Fat quarter blue fabric  
Fat quarter white fabric  
1 1/2 yards beaded trim  
12" pillow form

### Cutting

2 squares, 7" x 7" blue  
2 squares, 7" x 7" white  
1 square, 13" x 13" white (backing)

### Instructions

1. Sew a blue and white square together with right sides together using a 1/2" seam allowance. Repeat.
2. Sew pairs of squares together to form the pillow front.
3. Place trim along outside edge of pillow front, then baste in place.
4. Place pillow front and back with right sides together; sew with a 1/2" seam allowance leaving a 6" opening. Be careful not to catch trim in sewing.
5. Turn pillow cover right side out. Check to see if any of the trim is caught in the stitching and fix if necessary.
6. Push pillow form through opening and then sew opening closed.
